In 2031 I looked at your tables and graphs on your website and could not use those to take a determination as to how low the water was. I think a notice with our bill would be one good place to state this. Maybe a sign in town with the water level status. It is imperative people know if we are close to running out or very low, including because they will conserve to the utmost then. In 2021 I thought since we were still allowed to water outdoors that we were not very low. Your resolutions and watches appear to focus on notifying the public about water restrictions only.
