Cambria Desalination Project Receives “Stimulus” Funding.

Cambria, CA--- The U.S. Army Corps of Engineers announced today that it will receive \$2.5 million in funding through the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act (ARRA) to develop Cambria’s desalination project. The Corps’ Los Angeles District received a total of \$184 million through the ARRA, referred to as the “stimulus package”, passed in February by President Barack Obama.

The Corps will continue the work on Cambria’s Desalination project, which is critical to establishing a long-term, stable water supply in the town. When a suitable site in Cambria is located, the Corps will prepare construction plans, specifications, environmental documentation, and projects costs. Additional funding will be required to construct the facility.

According to Greg Sanders, President of the Cambria Community Services District (CCSD) Board, “This funding will go a long way towards solving Cambria’s severe water shortage problem. The community of Cambria sincerely appreciates the commitment of Congresswoman Capps and the Corps of Engineers to the desalination project.”
