***Cambria, CA***—On Saturday, September 28, the Chalk Fire began north of Nacimiento Ferguson Road in the Las Padres National Forest. It has now burned 1,000 acres. A large smoke column is visible from Highway 46 and the upper elevations of Cambria. The fire is moving in the direction of Cambria and may approach the San Luis Obispo County line in a couple of days.

Citizens are asked to stay alert to the changing conditions of this fire and note that until we receive 1-2 inches of rain, our coastal area is extremely vulnerable to wildfire as Cambria's watershed and vegetation are at their driest point.
