- WHY:** In the event of a large-scale disaster, the normal Emergency Response Agencies that serve you will be overwhelmed and they might not be able to assist you for up to 72 hours (it's simply, a supply and demand issue).
- WHO:** Sponsored by: **Cambria Fire Department, Cambria Health Care District, SLO County Fire Chiefs Assoc. & SLO County Sheriffs Advisory Council and San Luis Ambulance.**
- WHAT:** CERT is a 20-hour "hands-on" course that teaches individuals to be better prepared in the event of a major disaster, and to form into effective neighborhood teams to assist others. In the CERT training class you will learn about how and when to turn off your **Utilities; Firefighting** skills; **Medical** skills; **Hazardous Materials & Terrorism** awareness; light **Search and Rescue** techniques; and most importantly, you'll learn **SELF RELIANCE**.
- WHERE:** Cambria Fire Department, 2850 Burton Drive, Cambria [927-6240] & Rabobank, 1070 Main St., Cambria. **The 1st class is at the Fire Dept.**
- WHEN:** Five evening classes, each covering different topics and beginning at 6 pm; Mon.-**Oct. 20**, Wed.-**Oct, 22**, Mon.-**Oct. 27**, Mon.-**Oct. 29** & Mon.-**Nov. 3**. The first class session on Oct. 20th will be at the Cambria Fire Department.
- COST:** There is a **\$40** materials fee that provides you with a student manual and a "CERT bag" that includes a helmet, gloves, vest, goggles, etc.

The \$40 fee is due by October 15th, 2008.
