### 1. Why do you want to serve as a CCSD Board of Director?

I have owned property in Cambria since 1975, built my home here in 1984, and have been a full-time resident since 2001. I am proud of and committed to this community and desire to apply my formidable experience in government, public policy and public management to make the Cambria community even better.

### 2. What is your experience and/or background that qualifies you to be a Board member?

I have worked in government for nearly 50 years in various roles including analyst, lobbyist, executive director of a joint powers agency (JPA), and as a consultant to government agencies at the federal, state and local level. I have served on various Boards at the local, state and national level, examples include Governor's Advisory Board for Public Sector Labor Relations, Sacramento, CA; National Council and Executive Committee, American Society of Public Administration, Washington, DC; and Member of the Session, First Presbyterian Church, Fresno, CA. As a consultant I have guided numerous city councils, regulatory agencies and boards and commissions through the strategic planning process.

# 3. Identify the important objectives you would like to see the CCSD accomplish over the remainder of your appointed term.

First, focus on the District's mission statement and vision in a manner to maximize citizen involvement, transparency and consensus so we move into the future as one community. In years past, the CCSD has often been viewed as a divider, not a unifier and that perception needs to change. One of the top priorities of the Board as it moves forward must be to rebuild the trust of the whole community.

### 4. After reviewing the 2017 Board goals, what is your opinion regarding those goals?

As far as they go, and to the degree I understand them, the 2017 goals appear reasonable, valid and necessary. In regard to Goals 1 and 4, I would hope that the emphasis is on building higher levels of trust between the district and citizens. I would like the Board to consider and embrace a fifth goal which focuses on cleaning up the community; Cambria "Stumps-by-the-Sea" is unacceptable. It contributes to fire danger, is hazardous to persons and property, and compromises the ambiance for which Cambria is noted.

### ATTACHMENT A

I graduated magna cum laude from the University of Washington.

I started volunteering for political campaigns when I was 16 and have been doing so ever since, for both Republicans and Democrats.

I have extensive experience in all sides of the entertainment industry and media, including teaching, writing, directing, performing, and producing.

I owned and operated a successful retail business for 22 years. I bought my first house in Cambria 30 years ago, and finally moved into the house of my dreams here 5 years ago.

I am a member of the 432 American Legion auxiliary and a proud supporter of the Cambria Historical Society, Friends of

the Elephant Seals, and the California Coast National Monument.

The last 4 years I have been President of the board of directors for the Lompoc Theatre. As chair of operations during that time, I have dealt with myriad regulations and negotiated with many agencies including the Coastal Commission, the City of Lompoc, County of Santa Barbara, and State of California. I believe Climate Change is real, and the droughts and wildfires plaguing our state and our town will only intensify in the coming years. What we do now to address it will pay major dividends in the future.
