Director Thompson is concerned about the urgency of the project and would like to press forward quickly. Grant funds are available. Companies who handle these types of systems and perhaps they could provide a demonstration. He views this project as strictly an emergency project to bring water to this community as soon as possible.

Vice President Robinette: Thanked everyone for their questions. This is a hard place to be. There are no guarantees. Possibilities that we will have a big El Nino but there is also a possibility of no El Nino. We are hoping to turn this on in July. We need to be working on loans and other financial support right now. Can we be helping by attending meetings to help secure permits. People here want a solution. We would like to come back and look for alternatives in the future.

Director Clift: Concerned we started out with a July 1 target date moved to August and then Sept. Question to the Consultant is this due to work you are doing or because of other agencies that are taking up time. Who are these other agencies/people and how do we address these people by name. Happy to call out obstructionists. This is a Cambria project and we need to keep it for Cambria not others. OES for Ca. Gov. will be here tomorrow. We will ask what they can do to shorten the time of the permitting process. We have an emergency and need to act like we have
