Please consider revising the title of Option 2, "Reducing Concentrate Volume with Zero Liquid Discharge", to encompass other technologies in addition to the GWI "Zero Liquid Discharge" technology. For example, adding an additional reverse osmosis stage to the WRF using existing RO membrane technology could be a cost effective way to reduce concentrate volume.

Option 9, "Evaporation Pond", is still a viable alternative for concentrate disposal. New technologies exist to accelerate evaporation and reduce the required size of the pond. However, if the existing evaporation pond cannot be used, a new location and a new pond will be required. The "Cons" listed seem less significant, but negotiating a new location and constructing a new pond should be added.
