Hello. We would like to request that all wood chip medium placed inside the enclosed dog zones be cut to be no bigger than 1" overall.

- we have had pups cut their paws on large wood chips and as a result we can no longer use the dog park

- dogs that run hard are injured

- small dogs have difficulty navigating the large heavy wood

It's our understanding that the chipper maybe calibrated to cut small pieces.

Yes it takes more time to produce , but the end result will help reduce injury (vet bills)

Thank you for this consideration.

Please let the community know when this upgrade is implemented. We will return at time and use the dog park.
