The Cambria Community Services District, located on the beautiful central coast of California approximately five miles south of Hearst Castle and 15 miles north of Morro Bay, seeks qualified and highly motivated individuals with a strong work ethic to fill one full-time Water Treatment Operator I or Water Treatment Operator II position.

The Cambria Community Services District serves a population of approximately 6500 and Cambria is considered one of the most desirable places to live in California. Within thirty minutes of San Luis Obispo and Paso Robles, Cambria offers a quality of life that provides unlimited outdoor amenities, rugged coastlines, rolling hills, clean air and a Mediterranean climate. Cambria offers excellent schools and a work environment that fosters teamwork, collaborative thinking and a sense of community.

The District shall provide the PERS 2% @ 60 retirement plan for covered employees who are "classic" members hired on or after October 1, 2012, including the 36 highest consecutive months' final compensation, and the employee shall pay one hundred percent (100%) of the employee paid member contribution, through a payroll deduction. As defined under the Public Employee Pension Reform Act (PEPRA), miscellaneous "non-classic" employees (aka new members) hired after January 1, 2013 shall be covered under the CalPERS 2% at 62 retirement benefit, including the 36 highest consecutive months' final compensation, and the employee shall pay one hundred percent (100%) of the employee paid member contribution, through a payroll deduction. Eligibility for other benefits provided to "non-classic employees" under this MOU through CalPERS (as stated above) shall be determined by the provisions of PEPRA for "non-classic employees" aka new members.

Under supervision of the Water System Supervisor, the Water Treatment Operator Grade I or Grade II installs, repairs, maintains and replaces water mains, meters, service connection and other water assists in the operation of the water supply, treatment, distribution, storage and pumping systems; reads meters; and, performs other duties as assigned.
