**Storm Warning**

**Cambria**—Beginning Tuesday evening, January 26, 2021, and projected through Friday, January 29, 2021, a FLASH FLOOD WATCH is in effect for the San Luis Obispo coasts and nearby foothills. This storm system will bring 36 to 48 hours of steady rain. Heavy rainfall rates near 2 to 3 inches per hour can result in flash flooding to roads and creeks. Remain alert and watch your property for flooding.

A HIGH WIND WARNING is in effect from 10 PM this evening until 10 AM Thursday, January 28, 2021. San Luis Obispo coasts and mountains will see 25 to 40 mph winds, with gusts to 65 mph expected. Damaging winds will blow down large objects such as trees and power lines. Power outages are expected. Travel may be difficult. Do not approach down power lines. Alert 911.

A HIGH SURF ADVISORY is in effect now until 6 PM Friday, COASTAL FLOOD ADVISORY is in effect from 4 AM Wednesday, January 27, 2021 to noon on Thursday, January 28, 2021. Large breaking waves of 10 to 16 feet with dangerous rip currents are expected. Remain out of the water and do not drive around barricades or through water of unknown depth.

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
