A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS
OF THE CAMBRIA COMMUNITY SERVICES DISTRICT
APPROVING THE FIRE SUPPRESSION BENEFIT ASSESSMENT CONSUMER PRICE INDEX
ADJUSTMENT IN THE AMOUNT OF 2.8% FOR FISCAL YEAR 2026/2027
AND AUTHORIZING COLLECTION ON THE TAX ROLLS

WHEREAS, in accordance with the authority in Government Code Section 61122, a community services district may levy benefit assessments for operation and maintenance consistent with the requirements of Article XIID of the California Constitution; and

WHEREAS, the Fire Suppression Benefit Assessment, which included a consumer price index adjustment provision, was approved by the property owners in Cambria in March 2003 pursuant to Government Code Section 50078 et seq.; and

WHEREAS, Government Code Section 50078.16 states that the Board of Directors may provide for the collection of the assessment in the same manner and subject to the same penalties as other fees, charges, and taxes fixed and collected by or on behalf of the District and further provides that the County may deduct its reasonable costs incurred for that service before remittal of the balance to the District.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Directors of the Cambria Community Services District as follows:

1. That the recitals set forth above are true and correct and are incorporated herein by reference.
2. A Fire Suppression Benefit Assessment Consumer Price Index Adjustment in the amount of 2.8%, effective July 1, 2026, in compliance with Resolution 27-2003, and the related Engineer’s Report is hereby approved.
3. The following Fire Suppression Benefit Assessments for Fiscal Year 2026/2027 are hereby approved:

Vacant Lot	\$25.46
Single Family Residence < 3600 sq. ft	\$127.29
Single Family Residence > 3600 sq. ft	\$190.99
Multi-Family Residence per Dwelling Unit	\$63.67
Commercial Range	\$382.30 - \$3,251.76

4. For the 2026-27 fiscal year, pursuant to the authority in Government Code Section 50078.16, the Board of Directors hereby elects to collect the District’s Fire Suppression Benefit Assessment on the County of San Luis Obispo real property tax roll in the same manner, by the same person, and at the same time, together with and not separate from its taxes.
