MAINTENANCE TECHNICIAN JOB ANNOUNCEMENT

\$44,555 - \$54,156, per year

The Cambria Community Services District, located on the beautiful central coast of California approximately five miles south of Hearst Castle and 15 miles north of Morro Bay, seeks qualified and highly motivated individuals with a strong work ethic to fill one full-time Maintenance Technician position.

The Cambria Community Services District serves a population of approximately 6500 and Cambria is considered one of the most desirable places to live in California. Within thirty minutes of San Luis Obispo and Paso Robles, Cambria offers a quality of life that provides unlimited outdoor amenities, rugged coastlines, rolling hills, clean air and a Mediterranean climate. Cambria offers excellent schools and a work environment that fosters teamwork, collaborative thinking and a sense of community.

The District shall provide the PERS 2% @ 60 retirement plan for covered employees who are "classic" members hired on or after October 1, 2012, including the 36 highest consecutive months' final compensation, and the employee shall pay one hundred percent (100%) of the employee paid member contribution, through a payroll deduction. As defined under the Public Employee Pension Reform Act (PEPRA), miscellaneous "non-classic" employees (aka new members) hired after January 1, 2013 shall be covered under the CalPERS 2% at 62 retirement benefit, including the 36 highest consecutive months' final compensation, and the employee shall pay one hundred percent (100%) of the employee paid member contribution, through a payroll deduction. Eligibility for other benefits provided to "non-classic employees" under this MOU through CalPERS (as stated above) shall be determined by the provisions of PEPRA for "non-classic employees" aka new members.

Under the general supervision of the Facilities & Resources Supervisor, the Maintenance Technician performs a variety of building, facilities, landscape, parks, trails and open space maintenance and related activities on CCSD properties and facilities. This position performs physically demanding tasks indoors and outdoors, in a variety of weather conditions, and operates tools, equipment and district vehicles.

The minimum qualifications for the Maintenance Technician include willing to work nights, weekends and holidays, depending on the assigned schedule; may be required to work a split shift; able to work with a minimum of supervision; able to perform a variety of physically demanding tasks, including lifting and carrying objects in excess of 50 pounds, as needed; able

to operate a variety of hand tools, power tools and construction/maintenance equipment; knowledge of basic facilities and buildings custodial and maintenance practices; knowledge of basic electrical, plumbing, landscape and electrical maintenance activities; ability to climb a ladder and perform duties in confined spaces; ability to read and understand basic maintenance manuals and procedures.

Experience: Equivalent of two years experience in janitorial, general maintenance, construction or related work.

Education: Equivalent to High School graduate or G.E.D.

Licenses: Must possess and maintain a valid California class "C" driver's license and maintain a satisfactory DMV record to maintain District insurability.
