The CCSD urges customers to shut off the water supply to homes or businesses when away for an extended period of time. Part-timer? Going on vacation? Shut off your water at the main inlet to your home to prevent costly water loss or property damage from undetected leaks.

Want to stop leaks in their tracks? Invest in a residential leak detection system such as the **Flume Smart Water System** or **FLO Smart Water Detector by Moen**. These devices detect water loss and alert you or a designated emergency contact. The **FLO** will even shut off your water supply automatically when water loss is detected. SPRING INTO SAFETY

Spring is coming, and you may be considering DIY home improvements and new plantings. The CCSD would like to remind you to please **Call 811** before you dig to ensure underground utilities are not damaged during your next project.

Did you know?

Certain plants are more skilled at finding water than others. When planting anything with an extensive root system (such as digger pines and redwood), be sure to plant them away from your water line and meter. Per the CCSD municipal code, the space around your water meter must be free from obstruction--including shrubs and trees!
